***What would you like Norwich's Alumni Relations program and the NU Alumni Association to look like?***

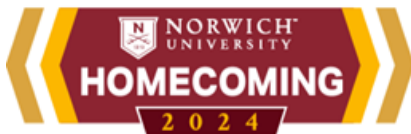

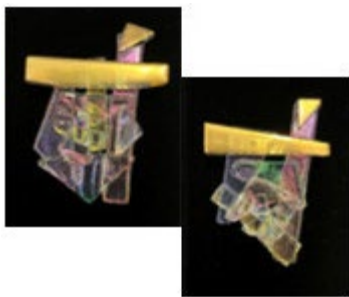
